








1 Single texts to provide a variety of outcomes

The Emperor's Egg	Martin Jenkins		Information about Emperor penguins	Reader knows interesting information about Emperor penguins.



Fear – Lower KS2

Fox	Margaret Wild and Ron Brooks		Story about a creature being afraid of another in the present tense.	Reader feels afraid.
Little Mouse's Big Book of Beasts	Emily Gravett		Labelled and captioned plan to show how a frightening creature could be made less frightening.	Reader is amused and entertained by the ideas shown.
