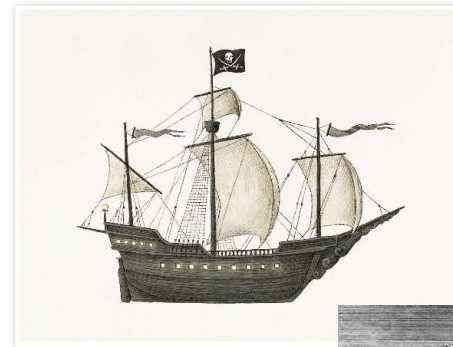


## Key knowledge to be taught:

- ❑ Pirates were sailors who lived in the past. They sailed on ships across the seas. They attacked other ships and stole goods. They looked for treasure - valuable things, which is not always gold.
- ❑ Most pirates sailed in the Atlantic Ocean and the Caribbean sea. They sailed west from Europe to the Caribbean.
- ❑ Anne Bonny lived about 300 years ago. She travelled on pirate ships in the Caribbean Sea. She joined a pirate crew led by Calico Jack. She fought in battles and was known for being brave and fierce. She became famous because very few women were pirates at that time.

- ✓ Explain how specific artefacts help us learn about the past

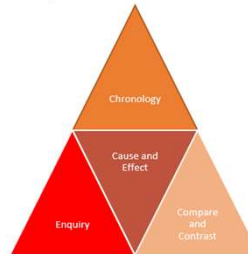


**Invasion:** What impact did pirate invasion have on the world?
